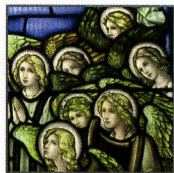

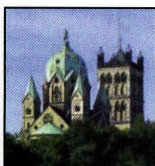


BRENDON LUKIN,

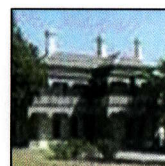

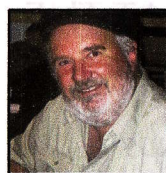
